



2022 KCT Stirling Scholarship for Final Year Survey and Spatial Students

Scholarship

The scholarship, promoted by the family of Ian and Margaret Stirling, includes:

- A \$2500 cash award
- Attendance at the 2022 S+SNZ Annual Conference including registration, travel, and accommodation costs – www.surveyspatialconference.org (1-3 August 2022- Novotel Lakeside Hotel, Rotorua)
- A 5 minute presentation of their winning submission at the conference.
- A 30 minute session with major sponsor GSI Insurance Partners re planning for the future
- Student membership of S+SNZ if not already a member

Eligibility:

Applications are open to final year students enrolled in a Surveying, Spatial or GIS related course at a New Zealand university or other New Zealand tertiary institute who are New Zealand citizens or permanent residents.

Selection criteria

Selection of successful applicant will be based on the following:

- Eligibility requirements being met
- Information provided by the applicant including a letter stating:
 - i. why you are taking a Survey and Spatial related course or programme
 - ii. why you are applying for this scholarship
- In keeping with the 2022 conference theme of *'Turning up The Heat'*, submission of a short (< 750 words) essay on *'The challenges for the early year survey and spatial graduate in a rapidly evolving market'*
- Prior tertiary study results
- Referee feedback (for shortlisted applicants).
